Bike

Since we're in Amsterdam, the best way to get to the international office is, of course, by bike! Click here for a [route planner/map](#) to help you plan your journey.

Tram

Tram 2 runs from Centraal Station or Nieuw Sloten past the end of Ottho Heldringstraat.

If you are on tram 2, heading West (to Nieuw Sloten) you should get off at Heemstedestraat (Metro station). Walk a short distance in the direction of the tram; Ottho Heldringstraat is the first street to the left and the office is on the left side (next to Cirque du Soleil).

If you are on tram 2 heading East (to Centraal Station), you should get off at Heemstedestraat

(Metro station). Walk a short distance back on yourself; Ottho Heldringstraat is the first street to the left and the office is on the left side (next to Cirque du Soleil).

Trams 1 & 17 also run reasonably close to the office.

Bus

Buses 247, 44, 23, 64, 18, 64, 281, 145, 197 all run close to the office.

Metro

Metro line 50 runs close to the office. It runs all the way to Isolatorweg (near Sloterdijk) and to Gein (in the South East). The closest stop to the office is Heemstedestraat. When you get off at Heemstedestraat you go down the steps, over the bridge and turn right. Walk a short distance; Ottho Heldringstraat is the first street to the left and the office is on the left side (next to Cirque du Soleil).

Train

Whichever train route you use into Amsterdam, you can always get onto the Metro line 50.

Coming from Den Haag, Leiden, Zaandam, Schiphol, Lelystad or Almere, you need to go to **Station Lelylaan**. From here you can walk (around 15 minutes, see map) or get the Metro line 50 one stop (heading South towards Gein). Get off at Heemstedestraat Station and go down the steps, over the bridge and turn right. Walk a short distance; Ottho Heldringstraat is the first street to the left and the office is on the left side (next to Cirque du Soleil).

Coming from Weesp, Bussum, you need to go to **Station Zuid WTC**, then get the Metro line 50 three stops (heading North towards Isolatorweg). Get off at Heemstedestraat Station and go down the steps, over the bridge and turn right. Walk a short distance; Ottho Heldringstraat is the first street to the left and the office is on the left side (next to Cirque du Soleil).

Coming from Utrecht, Arnhem, Apeldoorn or Amersfoort, you need to go to **Station Duivendrecht**, then get the Metro line 50 seven stops (heading North towards Isolatorweg). Get off at Heemstedestraat Station and go down the steps, over the bridge and turn right. Walk a short distance; Ottho Heldringstraat is the first street to the left and the office is on the left side (next to Cirque du Soleil).

Coming from Haarlem, Zaandam or Alkmaar, you need to go to **Station Sloterdijk**, then get the Metro line 50 five stops (heading South towards Gein). Get off at Heemstedestraat Station and go down the steps, over the bridge and turn right. Walk a short distance; Ottho Heldringstraat is the first street to the left and the office is on the left side (next to Cirque du Soleil).

Car

There are only two private parking spaces by the office and these are kept free for couriers, deliveries and guests. From Schiphol Airport

At Schiphol Airport check the train timetable screens for 'Amsterdam Lelylaan'. Trains depart frequently from either platform (spoor) 1, 2 or 3. The train journey to Amsterdam Lelylaan takes around 7 minutes. From here it's easiest to get the Metro line 50 one stop (heading South towards Gein). Get off at Heemstedestraat Station and go down the steps, over the bridge and turn right. Walk a short distance; Ottho Heldringstraat is the first street to the left and the office is on the left side (next to Cirque du Soleil).
